

Co-Taught Math 8

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This is a state required class and as such your student should pass all four terms. Passing means 70% or better on all academic work. If this is not accomplished the first time an assignment is handed in, the student will be expected to re-work the assignment until it is at least 70%. There is no one big assignment that will “make or break” your students grade, so there also no one assignment that can catch them up either. Day to day assignments make up most of your student’s grade

I will provide a list of assignments and scores of student performance on the Internet under our Power School Web site www.centennial.provo.edu. ***This will be updated at least once a week.*** You may access it as often as you wish. I will also send home a ***hard copy*** of your student’s grades ***once a week (usually on Wed).*** ***Please ask your student to see their grade report weekly. Having you sign it each week is part of their homework grade.***

Materials

Paper, pencil (pens - black and blue only), notebook for keeping notes, and some kind of folder to keep assignments in. All current assignments, textbook, paper and pencil should be brought to class each day.

Grading

Grades will be assigned using the following percentages

70% daily assignments – homework, parent signatures

30% tests and quizzes

Daily Assignments and late work.

Daily assignments should be brought with you to class. If you are in class your homework and notes should be with you.

Any grade below a C- (70%) is unacceptable and should be brought up by doing a re-work of the assignment. Doing a re-work simply means redoing only the problems missed, on a new sheet of paper, then stapling that new sheet on top of the original assignment and turning it back in. Any student can get full credit on any assignment by doing reworks. ***However, there is a 4-week time limit on each assignment. After 4 weeks reworks for that particular assignment will no longer be accepted.*** Reworks can be done at home, during Plus time, or after school in Assisted Studies, provided the assignment was turned in on time. If a student is in class but does not have their homework done or with them, then I will require them to come in during lunch to make up the assignment. If a student is ill or has an excused absence he/she still needs to complete the assignment within the 4-week time limit.
