## **Class Overview**

This class is designed to provide academic support as well as the time necessary to complete school assignments. We will also focus on study skills and planning: abilities that are essential to your success as a student.

## **Key Assignments**

Students will be expected to meet with me once a week to discuss academic progress and goals. Students are expected to come to this discussion prepared with their filled-out class planning sheet so that we can use our meeting time most effectively. Students will turn in their planning sheets weekly.

## Grading

This class will be a pass/fail course. Your grade will be split evenly between participation and classwork. Every day, you can earn 10 participation points. Being disruptive, being off-task, leaving class, or distracting others may result in lost participation points. The other portion of your grade will be based on completion of your weekly planning sheet and attendance at weekly meetings.

## **Hall Pass**

If you need to leave class, you can do so by signing out at the back of the room and taking the hall pass. However, leaving class for any reason will result in lost participation points. Excessive use of the hall pass may result in a warning or a call home. Please do not leave class unless you absolutely need to, and refrain from leaving in the first or last 10 minutes, or during teacher instruction. Whenever possible, go during break. Our class time is precious!

- Homework or other assignments to work on in class
- Supplies for assignments
