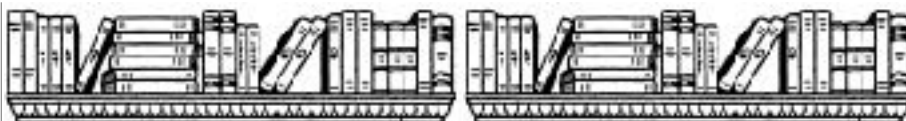

Class Overview

This class will challenge you to build on previous concepts and develop new expertise in mathematics. Topics will include rational numbers, exponents, radicals, proportional relationships, linear equations, similarities, geometric relationships, the Pythagorean Theorem, and statistical analysis.

Participation

Students will start every day with 10 participation points. Disrupting the class, distracting others, having a cell phone, leaving the room, being tardy, and not participating may result in lost participation points. Reasons for lost participation will be posted on PowerSchool.

Homework

Assignments from the textbook and other worksheets will be given regularly. Unless otherwise noted, all homework is due the class period after it is assigned. Most assignments will be available on the class Canvas site.

Quizzes & Tests

Quizzes and tests will be given regularly as a way to assess learning. Tests may be taken twice. However, a test may not be retaken until a test correction sheet has been filled out. Quizzes may not be retaken, but your lowest 2 quiz scores will be dropped.

Support Class

If you do not earn a C- or higher by the end of a term, the next term, you will be required to enroll in a Math 7 Support class or Academic Assistance.

Textbook

You will receive a copy of both textbooks, *Go Math - Middle School Grade 7*, and *Go Middle School - Grade 8*, which you will be expected to bring to class and use on homework assignments.

Late Work / Resubmissions

If you are not satisfied with a score on an assignment, you may resubmit it within a week of receiving your score. If you miss an assignment, you may turn it in within a week of the due date. Resubmitted assignments may earn up to 50% of the points back; late assignments will be graded at 75% unless extenuating circumstances exist (parents, please contact me).

Work Ethic

Math is hard, but it is always doable. In the front of my room it says, "Keep Trying Until You Succeed." Students in this class are expected to put forth their best effort, to actively engage in learning by asking questions and participating in classwork, and to establish a growth mindset.

Attendance

Attendance will be updated on PowerSchool at the beginning of each class period. If your student comes in late, it may show up as "absent" until I have a chance to edit the attendance. Tardy students are expected to sign in at the back of the room.

Hall Pass

If you need to leave class, you can do so by signing out at the back of the room and taking the hall pass. However, leaving class for any reason will result in lost participation points. Excessive use of the hall pass may result in a warning or a call home. Please do not leave class unless you absolutely need to, and refrain from leaving in the first or last 10 minutes, or during teacher instruction. Whenever possible, go during break. Our class time is precious!

Class Discipline

Students are expected to follow all school rules, as well as respect the rules and procedures of my classroom. Problems in class will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. Teacher intervention may include a verbal warning, loss of participation points, a call home, a referral to the office, and detention.
